

## **Addendum to Eddisbury Way guide: alternative start/finish in Frodsham**

If starting from Frodsham Bridge, please note that the Bridge Inn no longer exists. An easy and convenient alternative is to start or finish the walk in the centre of Frodsham at the Sandstone Trail pillar and traffic lights at the junction of the A56 (Main Street / High Street) with the B5152 (Church Street) (grid ref SJ 517 779) This is just down from the station where there is good parking – especially on the south side of the tracks. The Sandstone Trail and the Delamere Way also start and finish here.

### Frodsham to Higher Burwardsley

From the A56/B5152 junction, go northeast up the A56 (towards Warrington) using the pedestrian walkway on the right-hand side of the road. After about 230 yards, where steps descend to the road, turn right up a ginnel between houses. Follow this path, cross the railway by a footbridge and in a few yards, at a footpath junction, bear left to reach a road (Blue Hatch). Follow this road to Fluin Lane (B5439); turn left and then shortly right into Langdale Way. Follow this up to its end, where it meets Townfield Lane, which is a track (a restricted byway). Turn right on to the track, passing a play area and then houses on your right, and take the first path on the left (another restricted byway). Follow this down to where a path joins from the left down some steps (grid ref SJ 530 776). You are in the sunken lane mentioned in the first sentence of the second paragraph of the guide, and can pick up the instructions by continuing ahead down to the bridge, over the stream etc.

### Higher Burwardsley to Frodsham

At grid ref SJ 530 776) instead of climbing the stone steps on the right, as mentioned in the third paragraph of the last page of the guide, continue ahead up the track, to where it meets another track at a T-junction. Turn right on this (Townfield Lane) and follow it, passing a play area on the left, to where it meets the end of Langdale Way on the left. Turn left and follow the road down to its end at Fluin Lane (B5439). Turn left and shortly right into Blue Hatch with the Community centre on your left. Keep ahead on Blue Hatch, ignoring turnings to the right, and at the end of the road continue straight on for a few yards and then, at a footpath junction, keep right to cross the railway by a footbridge. Continue on the path until it reaches the A56 road. Turn left and follow the road for about 230 yards to its junction with the B5152 (Church Street) and the end of the Eddisbury Way.
