

Recommended alternative route from Marbury Park to Great Budworth Church

On reaching the public conveniences, turn right and follow the paths to the shore of Budworth Mere. On reaching the Mere, turn right to follow the path beside the Mere until you reach the footbridge. Cross the bridge and continue along the permissive path with the Mere on your left and then follow the field edge to the road. Cross the road with care and turn left. At the gate on your right, you may go across the field path and then follow the field boundary with houses on the left and onwards to the Church. Alternatively, keep straight up the A559 road to the crossroads and the well house. Here turn right and go through the village to the church.

Recommended alternative route from Great Budworth Church to Marbury Park

At the front of the church, you may either go straight on through the village to the main road and the well house. Here turn left and go down the main road (A559) to a left-hand bend; cross with the care and take the permissive path along the right-hand field edge (not the public footpath beside the left-hand fence) . Alternatively, turn immediately left past the stocks. Follow the road and go straight ahead to a grass lane, pass through the gate and follow the field edge until the path cuts across to the gate to access the A559 and turn left along the road to the left hand bend, cross with care and take the permissive path as above. Turn left, at the corner cross and go through the gate follow the right path along the field edge and then the Mere side. Cross over the bridge and turn right and then left beside the Mere. Turn left at the first distinct path to leave the Mere. At the next junction turn right and keep to the path going right again. After passing the public conveniences on the right turn left to go along the lime tree avenue.
