

NCW Hooton – Dunham-on-the-Hill notes

Day 1: Hooton – Backford 16/8/23

Page 17 Hooton – Capenhurst

Para 2 line 1: Go across the main road *at the bollards to your left and continue ...*

Para 2 line 12: ...the hedge on your left *through several fields*, eventually reaching...

Capenhurst – Hooton

Para 1 line 1: Leave Capenhurst Lane *along a path* on the left...

Para 2 line 6: ...around a 90° left-hand bend...

Para 3 line 1: ,,,(next to a *pair of large gates*)...

Page 19 Capenhurst – Backford

Para 1 line 6: ...eventually *passing between two houses* to reach Povey Lane.

Para 2 line 1: ...then left along the *paved cycleway beside the road. Follow this past the M56 roundabout and over a railway bridge, then cross the road to enter Bridle Lane, using the refuge just beyond the junction. At the first corner go left...*

Para 2 line 11: ...bridge into a *field*.

Para 3 line 2: ...power lines *and follow them* to the A41...

Para 3 lines 7 and 9: Replace stile with *kissing gate*.

Para 3 line 11: Just *after the Backford 20-mph zone* begins, take a stile on the left into a *car park*.

Backford – Capenhurst

Para 1 lines 3 and 5: Replace stile with *kissing gate*.

Para 2 line 3: Replace stile with *kissing gate*.

Para 2 line 4: Omit ..a stile at..

Para 3 line 1: *Cross over using the refuge just to your right, then turn left along the paved cycleway beside the road. Follow this past the M56 roundabout...*

Para 3 line 6: take a path between *houses* into fields.

Day 2: Backford – Dunham-on-the-Hill 23/8/23.

Page 31 Backford – River Gowy

1st para: Just before 30mph limit: Left over stile now takes you through the car park of the Hospice. Head to rear left of car park for next stile.

2nd para: Go left at the lane, *bend right*, and at a T-Junction....

River Gowy - Backford Last 2 sentences: over a 2-rail fence into a car park cross to far side and go over a stile onto Gordon Lane where you turn right

Page 33 River Gowy – Dunham-on-the-Hill

1st para: After the railway, go aheadfootbridge. Follow the hedge on your left – the hedges have been removed but an isolated tree marks where the hedges met so head to the isolated tree and then turn left. Walk to the farm drive. Aim slightly right....

Dunham-on-the-Hill – River Gowy

Last para: ...pair of stiles either side of a farm drive. Cross the drive and ~~follow the hedge on your right over~~ (hedges have been removed) walk towards an isolated tree where you turn right heading for the tunnel (culvert⁵) under the railway line.
